









1. Christ-centred

- King of kings and Lord of lords Rev 19
- Saviour and Redeemer Heb 2: 14-15
- Teacher and Example John 11; Matt 28
- Treasure-keeper of all wisdom and knowledge, Colossians 2: 1-9
- Child-like dependence John 5: 19
- Secular curriculum plus Christian sauce is not a response worthy of our King
- Go for the maximum possible in a broken world

2. Patient-appropriate

- Patient/Person **not** in the centre, Christ is
- Appropriate:
 1. Fitting this patient in this situation at this time
 2. Dis-ease story: looking for the roots
 3. Life story: personal, community
 4. Relationships story: vertical, horizontal, internal

3. Staff-enabling

- Enabling, not exploitation
- Holotelistic Staff Care in all relevant areas:
 - Relationships: team, multi-professional, families
 - Management: work load, scheduling, organizational structure
 - Finance: salary, insurance, pension
- Learning environment incl. continual education
- Individualized staff career planning and implementation



4. Community-enhancing

- Holotelistic concept of health (Shalom) requires the optimization of relationships among all our relationship networks
- Our relationship networks: Tribe, people, marriage, faith community, nation, work, social

5. Bible-based

- Final authority is the Word of God: Do we bow?
- Health principles of the Bible to be applied
- Biblical view of human beings
- Biblical view of health and disease
- Four channels of transformation
 1. The good Christian in the workplace
 2. Healthcare work is ministry / mission
 3. Applying Bible Principles in the workplace
 4. Developing Biblical models of holotelistic healthcare




Holotelistic Health defined

 - Transcendent



- Disease is disturbed relationships in and between:
 - Inner human
 - Outer human
 - Relationship networks
 - Environment
 - Transcendent



6. Science-informed

- All truth is God's truth
- Followers of Jesus love the truth and The Truth
- **Both** science **and** faith; we avoid the trap of either-or thinking
- Professional competency very important
- Research absolutely essential for regular, complementary and alternative healthcare – eat the fish and throw away the fish-bones
- Evidence-Based Medicine as useful servant but not as budget-controlling tyrant

7.Spirituality-sensitive

- Recognizes and honours research on:
 - Faith and health (Int. Saline 1)
 - Religious coping mechanisms (Int. Saline 2?)
- The faith of the patient is important to the patient's health
- Healthcare professionals can stimulate patients to be more active in the area of faith without forcing their own religion on the patient
- Witnessing is a step by step process under God's guidance

8.Care-focused

- Holotelistic Care encompasses personal health, family health, health promotion, community health, public health, primary secondary and tertiary healthcare, intra and extramural care
- Integrates the above with church involvement in healthcare
- Healing not always possible; Care is
- Ultimate aim of both Care and Cure: Shalom
- Shalom includes all forms of healing, including miraculous healing and a victorious death

9.Ethics-contoured

Theological basis: Matthew 22: 37-39

Holotelistic ethics: How should we love our neighbour in healthcare?

As a science: Reverent, systematic, analytical and critical thinking about attitudes, decisions and behaviour of healthcare professionals.

We consider four basic perspectives: virtues, situations, duties and consequences

10.Aesthetics-inspired

- Holotelistic Care: As many aspects of aesthetics as possible in as many areas of healthcare as possible
- Architecture, interior decoration, dress code
- Therapy: Music therapy, creativity therapy, occupational therapy (design element)

11.Law-abiding

- Four types of law: Self-made, Society-made, Legal system-made and God-made
- Holotelistic Care:
 - Recognizes self-made and society-made laws can be detrimental to health
 - Obeys legal system-made laws as long as they do not go against God-made laws
 - Challenges and changes legal systems to align with God's laws

12.Budget-sustainable

- Relationism is a viable Christian alternative to capitalism or socialism
- Relationism deals with the tension between responsibility and solidarity much better than either capitalism or socialism
- Budgets need to be balanced in such a way that they will be sustainable also in the long term
- WWJD?

13.Environment-friendly


- In developed countries we discovered what we had after we lost it
- Major problem in many developing countries – are you going to follow the disastrous Western example? Most are doing it...
- Waste and garbage disposal, public health
- Pharmaceutical world – major challenges

14.Technology-served

- Make optimal use of technology for the greatest good of the most
- Technology within the contours of holotelistic ethics is of major benefit
- Outside those contours it is a life-threatening monster







Holoteleis – A brief study

- 1 Thessalonians 5: 23a - And the very God of peace sanctify you **wholly**
- Wholly = holoteleis (from holotelis)
- Holotelis = Holos + Telos
 - Holos = Whole
 - Telos = End (as goal, not as finish), Purpose
- **Thayer**: perfect, complete in all respects
- **Strong**: complete to the end
- Charles Wesley: *The word signifies wholly and perfectly; every part and all that concerns you; all that is of or about you.*

Holotelis

in Kittel (1,2)
in Bauer, Arndt, Gingrich (3)

1. Intensified 'holos': totally complete, through and through
2. Basic meaning: having attained the entire purpose
3. Quite complete, through and through

Theological Context: Integral Mission

- "Mission...describes everything the Church is sent into the world to do" John Stott
- **Integral / holistic:** to correct one-sided understanding of mission that majors on either vertical or horizontal dimension of mission

Integral Mission + Holistic Transformation

Integral mission / holistic transformation is the **proclamation and demonstration** of the gospel.

Proclamation has social consequences
as we call people to love and repentance
in all areas of life.

Social involvement has evangelistic consequences
as we bear witness to the transforming grace
of Jesus Christ.

Micah Challenge

Old Testament Sanitary Code

1. Personal cleanliness
2. Pure water supply
3. Sewage disposal
4. Early burial
5. Pure foods
6. Isolation of infectious diseases
7. Control sexually transmitted disease
8. Priests as health officers

1. Overt Holotelistic Model: hospital / clinic / consulting room / community health
2. Overt synergistic team ministry
3. Covert synergistic team ministry

Model 1: Overt Holotelistic Model

- Mission Hospitals
- Christian and Deaconess Hospitals
- Holotelistic Health Clinics
- Christian Community Development Projects
- Holotelistic care still needs to be developed further in most of the above places

M.2: Overt synergistic team ministry

- Partnership: Government / private / missions / organizations / churches
- Parish Nursing / Faith Community Nursing
- Primary healthcare projects
- Disaster Relief Programs
- 'Medical' Outreaches
- Chaplains / Volunteer chaplains / spiritual workers
- Church medical clinics

M.3: Covert synergistic team ministry

- Unofficial / hidden partnerships
- Everyday holotelistic healthcare service by believing healthcare professionals
- Believers in healthcare system help bring about connections with faith partners outside the system

Some examples of problems in the inner human

1. Will → Unable to make lasting commitments; unstable choices
2. Emotions → Fear, depression, guilt, rejection
3. Mind → Compulsive thoughts, poor self-image
4. Beliefs → Harmful beliefs
5. Understanding → Misinterpreting body language cues
6. Desires → Lust
7. Conscience → Callousness / over-sensitive

Whole human ↔ Transcendent OK?

 - God
 - Angels
 - Idols / evil spirits / demons / devil
- F.I.C.A.
 - **F**aith that could be of value to you now?
 - **I**nvolvement in that faith right now?
 - **C**ommunity of faith that could support you?
 - **A**ssistance needed in this area?
